

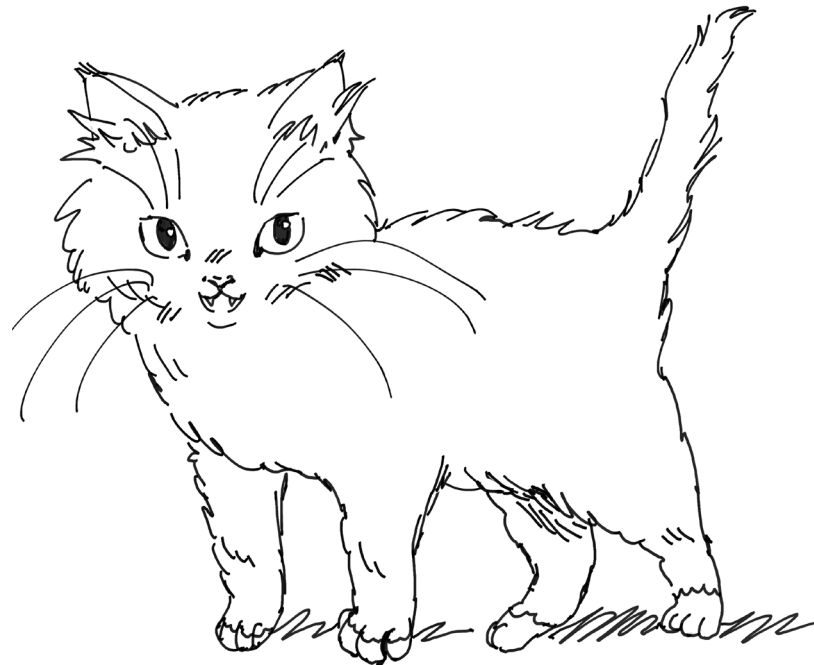
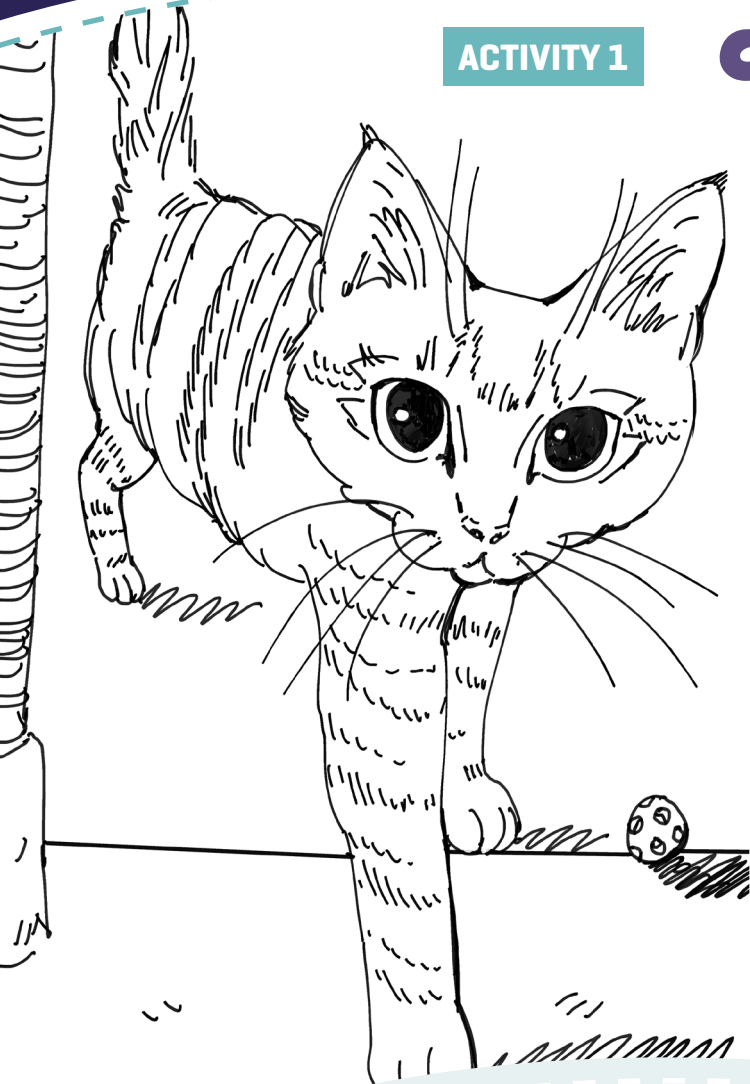

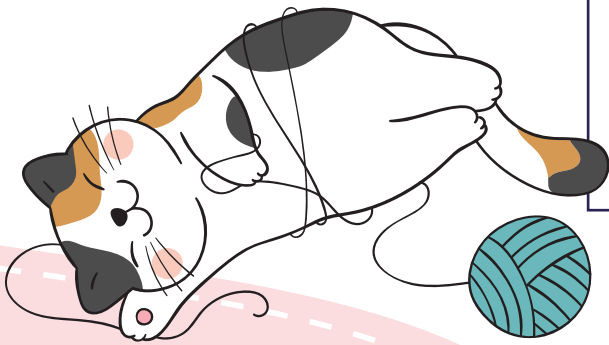

Cats are predators. Their instincts tell them to stalk, wiggle, chase, pounce and bite! Like you, cats need to play to be happy and healthy.

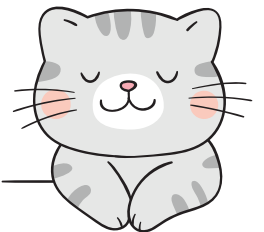
TIP: Always play with your cat using toys (never your hands or feet). Never touch their belly or when they are flicking their tail- these are times they might bite or scratch you.
